DESCRIPTION: Original front porch, wainscoting in ceiling not original. 1, windows with wood surrounds, shutters. Porch supported by four Doric columns. The back porch was originally open, now enclosed. The house has modified hip roof with front gable containing a diamond-shaped double window. There is a modern exterior chimney added to the right elevation. There is a boxed cornice with frieze and return and an interior chimney to the right of the roof peak.
