DESCRIPTION: There is a full width front porch supported by turned posts with decorative corner brackets. The main door has a single light transom above. There is a flat area at the peak of the hip roof which may originally have contained a widow's walk railing. The front and right elevation gables have sawtooth pattern shingles, boxed cornice, frieze and return. The rear elevation was possibly an open two-storey porch, now enclosed.
