DESCRIPTION: The full width front porch is supported by five pillars. Originally it wrapped to the left, but with the addition of a new chimney the porch has been cut in two. The main door is half-glass with two long panes and a single transom above. The front gable end is covered in sawtooth wood shingles. There is a bay window area on the left elevation.
