DESCRIPTION: Full-width front porch supported by decorative pilars and w  
slat balusters. This porch used to wrap to the left side, but that portion  
has now been enclosed. In the right bay there is a two storey bay window  
with flat roof. Bays do not extend the full length of the house. There is a  
boxed cornice with decorative frieze and return. Rear has various  
additions. Right side has sun porch with decorative trim under roof  
overhang, possibly added later.
