DESCRIPTION: Front porch ceiling is wainscoted. Stucco pillars support the full-width front porch. Arches on all three sides. Entire house has boxed cornice with small frieze, some decoration, wide overhang, wainscoting on underside. Rear elevation has slanted roof. Second storey was possibly a later addition. Roof and overhang has open rafters. Left side of rear is German siding and right side has been stuccoed. There is a garage with hipped roof and German siding.
