DESCRIPTION: This is a large bungalow style house with a full width front porch supported by elephantine columns on brick piers. There are four subtle arches under the porch ceiling. Front door appear original with beveled glass. Second storey of facade has a double 6/1 in each bay.

Right elevation: first floor, left bay has single casement and window with double sash six lights each sash. Right bay has double 6/1 d.h.s. There is an exterior chimney between the center and rear bay.

Most windows are 6/1. There are open eaves with rounded rafters and a wooden water table between the first and second storey. There is a small screened back porch and an addition on the left rear corner. The left elevation has a bay window area and an exterior chimney.

Interior: This is a side hall plan house with a dramatic wood columned entrance to the living room. The front hall has its original brass light fixtures. Doors are five-panel. There are triangular closets in the bedrooms and original light sconces on the walls.
