DESCRIPTION: Façade: Main door has architrave with recessed side lights. Principal windows are double hung sash with single lower light. Upper sash contains three squares over three long rectangles. The front door matches the window design of the side lights. Porch extends full width and is supported by Roman Doric columns. Second storey has same fenestration as front floor and a double casement window in the middle bay. There is a dormer in the roof line containing three small casement windows. Left elevation: Bay window area and assymetrical fenestration. Right elevation: middle bay is a shed-roofed two-storey oriel with double windows on the front. The rear elevation has a dormer like the facade and an enclosed porch on the first level. Present owner has lived there approximately 40 years. She says house was stucco on first level when she bought it.
