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DESCRIPTION: This is a typical Gaithersburg Style American four-square with a full-width front porch and a modified hip roof with cross gables. There are interior boxed gutters and decorative millwork at the top of the turned support posts. There is a side-by-side d.h.s. 1/1 in the right bay. The second floor has a 2/2 d.h.s. in each bay and there is a 1/1 d.h.s. window in the front gable with decorative scroll brackets at the eave ends. Right elevation: Symmetrical fenestration with a bay window area in the rear bay. Left elevation: symmetrical fenestration. Interior offset chimney.
