

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DESCRIPTION: Italianate type duplex in original condition except for rear addition which has been recently removed. Tall narrow 2/2 windows with two inch plain surrounds and plain entablature. Metal louvered shutters have replaced original wood ones on front facade, second level, and are missing on remainder. A small 2/2 window is located between first and second bay. Unusual feature: very tall, 6 foot, narrow 4/4 window on first level sides with two inch plain surround. Front porch extends full width and is supported by turned posts and plain railing, no balustrade. Except for addition of asbestos siding, 10-12 Park Avenue is identical.
