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DESCRIPTION: Front porch extends full width and is supported by four plain pillars The door appears to be original with raised panels below and single-light window in top half, two-light transom above. There is a three-bay wide bay window section on the left elevation, otherwise symmetrical fenestration. Rear has two-storey shed-roof addition with rafters exposed in the eaves, two doors side-by-side in first rear bay left. The right elevation has a 1/1 d.h.s in each bay and no gable.
