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DESCRIPTION: The porch extends the full width of the facade and is supported by elephantine columns on concrete piers, egg and dart molding, rusticated inset panel columns, plain wood hand railing. The symmetrical fenestration has plain surrounds and there is a round window in the front gable. There is an exterior chimney added to the east gable end and a diamond window in the west gable end. Original front door has three horizontal panels on bottom with one horizontal light at top. There is a one-light transom, plain surrounds and horizontal dentil molding strip.
