DESCRIPTION: This building has been substantially altered over the years with a drastic change in roof line, stuccoing, and fenestration. Originally on the northwest corner there was a tower section which was destroyed by fire. The remaining features of the original building are the built-up parapet, roof and course molding and unusual windows. There is a rounded glass arch transom above the main floor windows with architrave molding. Originally this was a very important structure for the town center. Some design features remain.
