DESCRIPTION: This is a late construction typical Gaithersburg Style house. The porch extends the full width and is supported by plain round columns. The right bay has a side-by-side d.h.s. 1/1 window. There is a diamond window in the front gable end. Symmetrical fenestration throughout. There is a rear addition enclosed porch with 6/6 windows. The chimney is at the peak of the roof line and is corbelled.
