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DESCRIPTION: Porch extends full width and is supported by four elephantine pillars on stretcher bond piers with plain square balustere and molded top and bottom railing. There door has side lights and is two-thirds glass with the bottom third being a plain wood panel. The first and third bay have side-by-side d.h.s. 1/1 windows. The half-storey has a front gable set in the cross gable roof line with broken return. There is a door flanked by 1/1 d.h.s. and a porch with plain square balusters. The first level of this house is covered in running bond brick facing. The half-storey is wood siding.
