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DESCRIPTION: A textbook example of the bungalow style, 25 Cedar has remained unchanged since construction. Special features are large gabled dormer with paired 6/1 windows, large front porch covered by overhanging roof supported by elephantine columns. Original entrance is intact with plain wood surround and vertical sidelights and full glass door with mullions in similar pattern to sidelights, and original wood screen. There is a triple set of 6/1 windows located in the first bay. Front and side dormers are decorated with wood square shingles. This house also is the location of the Geological Survey Marker just off the front porch.
