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DESCRIPTION: There is a projecting bay to the right side of the facade. The porch covers the first and second recessed bays and is supported by two elephantine columns with solid stucco between. There is a wide frieze, return with ogee molding. The left elevation has a 2/2 casement window in the wood shingled gable. The rear elevation has a shed-roofed addition which extends the width of the house. The center is a kitchen porch. There are no windows or shingles in rear gable. The right elevation has non-symmetrical placement of windows.
