There are four Doric columns supporting porch. Front door has two-light transom above. Regular spacing of d.h.s windows throughout. There is a jerkinhead gable with double 1/1 window. There is a chicken coop with a raised seam shed roof and brick foundation and a small clapboard barn with stone foundation with trap-door leading to second story.
