DESCRIPTION: House has original tin roof, wood siding and shutters. The front porch extends the full width and is supported by six Doric columns about 10' high. The left and right bays have 9 x 3 foot windows 2/2/2. The middle bay door has a recessed transom light with an ornamental cornice just below. The main part of the door is side by side concentric arches with raised center. Lower part of door is two rectangles of raised design side by side. There are three lights and bottom raised wood panel on either side of the door.

Second floor-regular spacing of 2/2 windows. Center gable with half-moon window.

Left elevation-several additions. Half-moon window in gable. Right elevation-several additions, half-moon window in gable.

Rear elevation-enclosed porch, German siding. Original house appears to have been L-shaped, but many additions have concealed the original plan.
