Description:

The Penelope Conn Property is a 1½-story, 3-bay, side-gable cottage with bungalow features on the north side of Bounding Bend Court in the Rockville vicinity of Montgomery County. Constructed circa 1930, the building is rectangular in plan and is located on a small lot. Within the past 10 years, new residential development has occurred on the land formerly belonging to the house. The house is now accessed by a curving driveway between two new houses from a court.

The structure has a side-gable roof, covered with asphalt shingles and has a shed dormer on the front and rear elevations. The house has a central brick chimney and an exterior end chimney on the west elevation. It is of wood frame construction with aluminum siding, and it has a stuccoed foundation. The windows are double-hung vinyl sash. The house has a 1-story, full-width shed roof porch on the front, or south elevation. The porch has four metal ornamental posts supported by concrete piers and the railings have been removed. Adjoining the front porch is a wooden deck on the west side of the house.

There is one outbuilding associated with this property. The shed is of wood frame construction with a front-gable roof covered with asphalt shingles, and wood siding. The structure is located northwest of the house.


The property is located on the north side of Bounding Bend Court, with residential property on all sides of the lot. There are trees on all sides of the house and a swimming pool to the west of the house. The property's setting has changed since the construction of the house. The building is now located within a mixed-use residential development of houses and townhouses.


