Description:

The Redland Baptist Church House is a 2-story, 3-bay side-gable cottage with bungalow features on the south side of Muncaster Mill Road in the Norbeck vicinity, Montgomery County. Constructed circa 1930, the structure has a 1-story, full-width, hipped roof porch on the front elevation and a 1-story, shed roof addition on the rear elevation.

The structure has an asphalt shingle roof, with shed roof wall dormers on both the front and rear elevations, and an exterior brick chimney. It is of wood frame construction with wood siding, it has a concrete foundation, and the windows are 3/1 wood sash. The front porch has tapered wood columns and a concrete floor.

There are no outbuildings associated with this building.

The property is located on the south side of Muncaster Mill Road, with residential properties to the east and south and an open field to the west. The property's setting is suburban, with considerable modern development in the surrounding area.


