The old Cashell family burying ground was located at the end of Argyle Club Road, near Layhill. The remains of 39 bodies were removed in July, 1972, to make way for expansion of Ross-moor Leisure World. The remains were finally (hopefully) re-interred at Rockville Union Cemetery in June, 1975, and marked with a monument.


