Description:

The Kim Property is a 1½-story, 3-bay side-gable cottage located on the east side of Norwood Road in the Norwood vicinity of Montgomery County. Constructed in 1934, the structure has a 1-story flat roof addition on the south elevation, which wraps around to the east elevation. According to the pastor of the Silver Spring Korean Baptist Church which now occupies the property, the addition was constructed after the church acquired the property in the 1960s.

The structure has a side-gable roof, covered with asphalt shingles and there are three, front-gable wall dormers on both the north and south elevations. The structure is of wood-frame construction with aluminum siding and it has concrete block foundation. The windows are 6/6, double-hung wood. The main entrance, located on the south elevation, includes a 9-light wood panel door with sidelights. A second entrance is located on the east elevation.

There are two additional structures associated with the property. A 1-story modern church building is located east of the house and has a flat roof and an aluminum exterior. The second outbuilding is a modern trailer located south of the house and southeast of the church building.

The property is located on the east side of Norwood Road with residences to the north. Its setting is a rural area located on a major regional traffic route.




