Description:

The Lee Property is a 1½-story, side-gable cottage located on the east side of Norwood Road in the Norwood vicinity of Montgomery County. Constructed in 1938, the structure has an exposed basement level on the rear elevation, due to the topography of the site, which contains a garage. The house has a screened porch on the north elevation and an interior brick chimney.

The structure has a side-gable roof, covered with asphalt shingles. There are two front-gable dormers on the front, or west elevation and a full-width shed roof dormer on the rear, or east elevation. The structure is of wood-frame construction which has been stuccoed; the gable ends are covered with asbestos siding. The windows are primarily 6/1, double-hung wood, and the structure has a concrete foundation which has been stuccoed. The front entry on the west elevation has a 1-light rectangular transom and an overhead garage door is located on the south elevation of the exposed basement level.

There are no outbuildings associated with the property.

The house is located on the east side of Norwood Road with residential property to the north and a former residence that was converted into a church to the south. Its setting is a suburban area along a major regional traffic route in Montgomery County.




