<p>The house is a small, one-story cabin with loft. It is of log construction, but the clapboard walls are covered further with asphalt siding. There are two bays on the main (south) facade. (A central door and one 6/6 double-hung window) There is a thin brick flue stack on the east end of the building. A shed-roof is tacked onto the back. Just west of this house is a two story, frame farmhouse sitting high on the bank of the road. This was the later 19th century home of the Hill family. Tom Hill was one of the lockkeepers here at the 7 Locks of the C&O Canal.</p> <p>Wm. Hill built the cabin and it is shown on the map of 1865. His son, (George Hill's grandfather) was born in 1867 and died at the age of 85). The grandfather ran a store in the east end of the house on the hill. The house part was added later, but still in the 19th century.</p>




