The house at 5511 Edson Lane is neither eligible for the National Register of Historic Places individually or as part of an historic district. The four-square house was an extremely common house type in the first decades of the 20th century. This house does not appear to be a particularly noteworthy example of the type. It appears to have been vacant for some time and to be in poor condition. According to Gwen Marcus, M-NCPPC Preservation Planner, the area in which it is located has undergone intense development in recent years and would not constitute an historic district.


