DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>This is a plain, two-story farmhouse that has been altered many times over the years. Still, it retains some features of interest.</p> <p>Originally of frame construction, it was covered with a brick veneer at least 30 years ago. The main (south) facade is of 5 bays. There was a central doorway, but this is now obscured by a one-story, brick enclosed porch across the front of the building. The roofline here is broken by a peaked center gable, and there is an internal chimney projecting through the east roof. Just west of center there is a large, early-looking chimneystack that sits atop the ridge; however, this faces north and south, while the present house runs east to west.</p> <p>The east end of the house is the most interesting view because the house has a definite, late Federal-style character about it. This is a 2 bay deep section, with chimneys on both sides of the ridge, and apparently there were fireplaces in this end. Perhaps the house was originally only 3 bays wide. This may account for the early-looking chimney which would have been attached to an ell running NW of the present house. There is an ell here presently, but it is impossible to determine how early it is due to alterations.</p>
