St. Luke's House, located at 615 E. University Blvd in Silver Spring, Montgomery County, MD is not located in an historic district nor is it considered eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

St. Luke's House is now a group home, but was originally constructed as a single-family residence. It was constructed in 1940 as one of a group of dwellings on small, raised and grassy lots which line the heavily travelled East University Blvd. The house is a 1-1/2-story, three-bay brick "Cape Cod" structure. The house is representative of the domestic buildings of the period and lacks the architectural distinctiveness to qualify for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places under Criterion C.

The property is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past and is thus not eligible under Criteria B or C.


