The Robert Duvall House was previously surveyed in 1998 and recommended ineligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places. The residence is estimated to have been demolished in 2008. The residence was extant on aerial High Resolution Imagery of 2007 but no longer shown in subsequent imagery of 2010 (Maryland Environmental Resources and Land Information Network [MERLIN]). Permit #475157 was issued on June 18, 2008 for the demolition of two single family dwellings listed as 2811 and 2801 Spencerville Road.



Description:

The Robert Duvall House is a 1½-story, 3-bay cottage on the south side of Spencerville Road in the Burtonsville vicinity, Montgomery County. Constructed circa 1920, the building has a side-gable, asphalt shingle roof with shed roof dormers on both the north and south elevations. The house is stuccoed and has an exterior brick chimney on the west facade. There is aluminum siding in the gable ends and on the shed dormers, and the windows are double-hung wood sash. The house has a front-gable hood over the front entrance and decorative brackets embellish the eaves of the main roof and door hood.

There are no outbuildings associated with this building.


The property is located on the south side of Spencerville Road, with residential property to the north, east, and west and open space to the south. The property's setting is suburban.
