This is a remodeled, country schoolhouse, that sits at the end of a short, secluded lane almost opposite Huntington Parkway. It is not immediately visible from the road. It is a one-story, frame structure, with the entrance in the south gable facade. The roof pitch appears to have been truncated from an A-roof to a low, gambrel-type.
