The house at 4916 Montgomery Lane is neither eligible for the National Register of Historic Places individually or as part of an historic district. The two-story stuccoed house with tudor details was probably constructed in the 1920s as a middle-class suburban residence. While it is visually interesting, it does not appear to be noteworthy enough to meet the criteria for individual listing. According to Gwen Marcus, M-NCPPC Preservation Planner, the area in which it is located would not constitute an historic district.


