Based on the available information, the house at 605 Woodside Parkway appears to be eligible for the National Register as a contributing resource in an as yet undefined South Woodside Park Historic District. Woodside Park (M: 36-18), located on the west side of Colesville Road, has been surveyed, but this neighborhood has not yet been studied. Based on the photographs provided, this section of South Woodside Park appears to be an architecturally cohesive residential neighborhood which could be eligible for the National Register under Criterion C as an example of the suburban development of metropolitan Washington, D.C. in the early decades of the 20th century. The modest circa 1928 cottage shows influences of the Bungalow and Tudor Revival styles, both of which enjoyed great popularity in this period. The house appears to retain excellent integrity and to be located in a row of homes similar in period, style and condition. In addition, the similarities in massing, lot size, setback of the houses and mature street trees contribute to the sense of a cohesive district. The streetscape is representative of middle class suburban development of the 1920s and 1930s, a time of great growth for Silver Spring and the inner suburbs of Washington, D.C.


