According to information prepared by SHA, Bridge #15060, a concrete slab structure constructed in 1929, does not meet the National Register criteria. Concrete slab structures such as this bridge were a highly redundant bridge form by the 1930s and Bridge #15060 has no particular historical or engineering significance. Numerous examples of similar bridges remain in the state. Bridge #15060 is not located in any known district.


