Prepare both a summary paragraph and a general description of the resource and its various elements as it exists today.

The Takoma Old Town Auto Service Center, formerly Glickman's Service Station, is an elaborate Tudor structure built of brick with a slate roof. The garage portion has a hip-on-gable roof atop a half-timbered gable. The other end of this roof abuts the side of (i.e., is perpendicular to) the roof of the office portion, which has half-timbered, stuccoed gable ends. A small brick chimney rises from the lower edge of the northeast roof. Slate and brick from a range of colors were used on this building, and large irregular pieces of stone form surrounds for doors and windows. Wood modillions support the cornice, and the gutters and downspouts are of copper.

The main elevation faces southeast onto Carroll Avenue, and consists of two windows and a door for the garage portion on the left, and a large show window and round-headed doorway to the office portion on the right. The show window consists of a single large pane of glass flanked on each side by a vertical row of several small lights. The sash is of wood. The window sits between two projecting brick piers which support a small, mansarded metal roof. The main doorway has its original round-headed, glazed, wood door set deep in a reveal. This reveal consists of a brick arch behind a massive surround of rough-cut stone of varying sized pieces, some of which form voussoirs for the arch. A tall, vertical, louvered vent in the half-timbered gable ventilates the attic over the office.

The northeast elevation faces Tulip Avenue and contains a round-headed window with a stone sill, a brick arch and stone impost blocks. To the right of this window is a projecting bay of wood, supported on brackets, and containing three windows separated by wood mullions whose bottoms are deteriorating. The upper sash of these windows contain nine lights; the lower sash have been replaced by plywood sheets. Above each window is a stucco panel. At the right end of this elevation is a segmentally arched doorway to the restrooms. Stone voussoirs form the arch, and occasional pieces of stone accent the doorway. The northwest elevation contains two small, rectangular windows lighting the restrooms. The southwest elevation contains double, wood-and-glazed garage doors.

Between the building and the street is a paved area which, until a few years ago, contained the gasoline pumps. These were removed by the present owner. The interior of the building is essentially unchanged from its original form and arrangement. The high-ceilinged office still has its wood shelving. Behind a door in its northwest wall a staircase leads to the attic, which is used for storage.
