Description:

The Schaeffer Property is a 1½-story, 5-bay side-gable cottage on the east side of Old Gunpowder Road in the Laurel vicinity, Prince George's County. Constructed circa 1945, the building has two enclosed shed roof porches on the north and south sides. The east facade has a treated lumber deck.

The structure has an asphalt shingle, side gable roof, with two gable dormers on the west elevation. There is a full width shed dormer on the east side. The west facade has a small gable roof entry porch of concrete masonry construction. It has brick veneer and stucco siding, and a brick veneer, concrete masonry foundation. The windows are double-hung wood sash.

There is one outbuilding associated with this property. The outbuilding is a garage, with a front gable roof covered with asphalt shingles. Constructed circa 1945, it is of concrete masonry construction and has a brick veneer and stucco exterior. The structure is located immediately southeast of the house.


The property is located on the east side of Old Gunpowder Road, with industrial property to the north, east and south. There are three trees on the site. The site is level, screened by trees on the north and east, and a ridge of bermed earth on the south side. The property's setting is rural, however it is surrounded by gravel mining operations.


