DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The building is a 2-1/2 story frame structure with a mansard roof covered by patterned shingles. On the north end are two large internal chimneys--one of which is covered with plaster. On one corner, the plate is exposed and reveals a pegged mortise and tenon joint for the corner post. The present five bay south and east facades have a porch across the first floor with pediments over the front steps. The pedimented roof dormers have brackets. The door has transom and side lights. The house is basically L-shaped with the porches on the outside of the two legs.

A square stone outbuilding stands on the north side of the main house.

Church demolished as of Sept. 1980; new church bldg. on site. Stone outbuilding remains.

Mrs. Margaret Beall Buchanan passed away early in December. She was born and grew up in Beltsville and occupied the property on which the Beltsville Baptist Church now stands until she moved to the District. After a fall a year ago she lived at the Washington Home where she suffered a stroke that took her life. She was 97.

Mrs. Buchanan was graduated from Gunston Hall and studied at Goucher College and Johns Hopkins University in Baltimore. She also attended the YWCA Social Work School in New York City.

During World War I, Mrs. Buchanan was appointed by the Governor of Maryland to organize civil defense committees for the state and later organized YWCA activities in North Carolina.

She was the daughter of the late Judge, Fillmore Beall. She married Thomas R. Buchanan, district relief director for the American Red Cross, in 1921.


Following his death in 1926, Mrs. Buchanan worked with the Friendship House, Hampshire House and Barney Neighborhood House in Washington for more than 25 years.

Mrs. Buchanan was a member of the District District Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution for more than 50 years, of the 20th Century Club, Washington and National Farm and Garden Clubs, and was active in the Johns Hopkins Alumni Association.

She leaves three sons, Condit, Fillmore Beall Buchanan of Giles Ferry, Conn.; Thomas R. Buchanan Jr. of Loris Lane, Falls Church, Va., and Robert B. Buchanan of Brownsville, Texas and eight grandchildren.

The family requests that expressions of sympathy be in the form of contributions to Children's Hospital.

Memorial services were held at All Souls Episcopal Church.

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

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
