







Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

The Norris House is a two bay, one story, side gable building with two additions. It was constructed circa 1948 and is now covered with vinyl siding. The roof is constructed of asphalt shingle, as is the addition's roof which also has a side gable roof. One addition is a screened in porch, while the second is a carport. The main living area has a three-part window, consisting of two 6-over-6 windows with one larger center pane that is undivided. There are attached shutters, painted pink with lighter pink diamonds on either side of the window. The front door also has six lights in the upper portion, while the rest is of wood construction.

The Norris House represents the independent suburban development of what was then a rural area of northern Prince George's County. The house lacks distinguishing architectural features and thus is not eligible under Criterion C (architecture) for the National Register of Historic Places. Furthermore, because the house is not part of a larger development, it cannot be considered an example of the important trends of suburbanization in Prince George's County, and thus it is not eligible under Criterion A. Based on this assessment, the Norris House is not eligible for inclusion for the National Register of Historic Places.
