Description Summary

7011 Woodland Avenue (Block 24, Lot 35 and half of Lot 34, Gilbert's Addition to Takoma Park) is a one-and one-half-story frame bungalow with a rectangular plan. The house rests on a concrete block foundation and is covered with asbestos shingles painted a medium blue. The house has a side-gable, asphalt shingle roof with deep overhanging eaves and exposed eave rafters. There is a prominent front-gable dormer centered in the main (south) slope of the roof. Across most of the first story main facade is a one-story porch with a front-gable roof supported by battered wooden columns on rusticated concrete block bases. Throughout the house there are 1/1 double-hung and multi-pane wood sash windows. The asbestos shingle exterior may be original to the house.

Significance Summary

7011 Woodland Drive, a Craftsman style bungalow constructed c. 1930, is significant as an Outstanding example of single-family residential construction found in Takoma Park and other developing streetcar suburbs of metropolitan Washington in the early 20th century. The exposed roof rafters, eave details, battered porch columns and rusticated concrete block foundation are typical of the materials used for the Craftsman style throughout the 1920s and 1930s. A twin to the house, located at 7013 Woodland Avenue, has been covered with vinyl siding and a number of windows have been replaced. The House at 7011 Woodland Avenue is an Outstanding Resource in the proposed Takoma Park Historic District.




