Based on the available information, the Washington-McLaughlin Christian School does not appear to be eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places. The school, formerly known as the J. Enos Ray Elementary School, was constructed in 1929 as Prince Georges County public elementary school. While the school undoubtedly possesses local significance under Criterion A, for its role as an educational center for the surrounding community and reflects the growth of the close-in Washington suburbs in the 1920s, it no longer retains sufficient integrity to convey its significance. Two subsequent additions, dating to 1943 and 1947, dwarf the original 1929 section. The original section has suffered substantial alterations including window replacement, blocking of windows, and nearly complete interior renovation. The property is located outside both the National Register listed Takoma Park Historic District and the area which this office believes may constitute an expanded district.

The school building currently houses a private school (1947 section) and an adult day care center (1943 section), and is slated to house eight senior apartments (1929 section).


