There appears to be some confusion over the precise location of each graveyard. The Walker family plot, enclosed by a fence, is located at the top of a hill at "Indian Springs"-a section of Greenbelt Lake Park. Mr. Mayo Attick, of the town's Public Works Dep't., knows of the other locations. He at one time removed stones from the sites-all of which have been badly vandalized.
