Based on available information the structure at 3806 39th St., Brentwood, Md., is not located within the boundaries of a state listed historic district and does not meet the criteria for individual listing on the Maryland Register. The two story, flat roofed, masonry structure is typical of multi-family apartment blocks built within the area prior to WW II. The three bay structure exhibits little detailing other than a cast stone door surround and suspended metal and glass canopy at the central, main entrance. The structure lacks the architectural distinction to qualify for listing under Criterion C. The property is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past, and thus does not qualify under Criteria A or B.


