4402 39th Street does not meet the National Register Criteria for individual listing nor is located in a National Register eligible district.

The small gable roofed brick cottage appears to have been constructed in the 1940s or 1950s as a very modest interpretation of a common house type of the period. It does not have any architectural significance and is not associated with any known significant event or person. The house is located in the Brentwood Survey Area (PG 68-12). This area began as an early residential suburb of Washington, D.C. in the 1890s. Located at the edge of the city and connected by railroad, Brentwood attracted both whites and blacks of the lower middle class, many of whom worked in Washington or on the development of the Brentwood development. The area continued to grow throughout the first half of the 20th century and is characterized by a mixture of 20th century residential architecture from victorian I-house to rambler, which can often be found within a single block. There is much non-historic construction scattered throughout the survey area and much alteration of the historic buildings. As a result, the survey area lacks cohesiveness and fails to convey a strong sense of the late 19th and early 20th century suburb. Further research could identify a smaller intact district, group of buildings or building located within the larger survey area which would meet the National Register Criteria for Evaluation. However the area immediately surrounding 4402 39th Street would not constitute a district.
