Prepare both a summary paragraph and a general description of the resource and its various elements as it exists today.

3824 34th Street is a two story, painted brick dwelling with a rectangular plan and a cross gable roof covered with asphalt shingles. (See Slide #25.) The building has been altered, at least in part, for commercial purposes and contains a storefront office at the first story. The first story of the east (34th Street) facade contains a single wooden door entry with transom at right (north) sheltered by a semi-circular fixed canopy. At left (south) is a large rectangular plate glass window flanked by tall, fixed-pane windows. The second story contains two, 1/1 double-hung sash windows spaced evenly across the facade. The gable-end attic contains a single rectangular window. The second story and attic windows of the main facade are sheltered by aluminum awnings, as are the second story windows of the north and south facades. To the rear (west) of the two story building is a one story unpainted brick addition of irregular plan with a flat roof. The addition is recent in character and is non-historic. Although the main facade has been substantially altered with incompatible windows, entry door and awnings, the two story portion of the building retains what appears to be its early 20th century plan and cross gable roof configuration.
