

Built about 1940-1941 the shops were designed to fit between the Wollworth building and a parking lot. Single story, limestone brick. 5310; Tailor shop and Antique store, were formerly a contractor's office and a Ladies wear shop. (5312) 5314; Coffee Shop, formerly a men's wear shop, the front has been substantially altered by the insertion of smaller windows and the stuccoing of the facade. The light windows above the display windows have been blocked by vertical vinyl siding.
