Based on the available information, the Joseph S. Schwalier House, currently known as Mount of God Baptist Church, located at 504 Brightseat Road, would not meet the National Register Criteria for individual listing. The circa 1930s frame dwelling was, as constructed, an undistinguished cottage with little, if any, architectural merit. Subsequent alterations, including those undertaken in the last decade for conversion of the property to a church, have substantially eroded its integrity. Therefore, the property does not appear to be eligible under Criterion C. In addition, the property has no known associations with significant events or people and thus is unlikely to be eligible under Criteria A or B. It is located in a rapidly developing area that would not constitute an historic district.


