The early 20th-century dwelling located at 807 58th Avenue in Fairmount Heights, Maryland is considered a contributing resource in the National Register-eligible Fairmount Heights Historic District. Fairmount Heights was established in the early 20th century as an African American suburb of Washington, D.C. The community illustrates the early migration of blacks to the suburbs within the same time-frame that whites were leaving the city for the more middle-class suburbs. The architecture of Fairmount Heights is generally modest and reflects the socio-economic status of the African American community in the early 20th century.

The house at 807 58th Avenue is located within the earliest platted section of the community and near the center of the area identified by the survey of the community as having the greatest concentration of historic buildings. Although the house has been altered, it retains sufficient integrity to contribute to the district in terms of location, design, setting, materials, workmanship, feeling and association.




