DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a two-story, frame farmhouse that sits at the end of a dirt road, north of White House Rd. It faces south, and has a five bay facade with a central door. There is a small center gable, with patterned shingles on the roof here. The gable ends also have patterned shingles. Two stove chimneys are centered in the roof ridge. Windows are 2/2, and present siding is asbestos shingle. A one-story Victorian porch with turned posts spans the front. House is abandoned and vandalized. Sits on tract awaiting development.


