Description:

The Mitchellville Blacksmith's House, surveyed by the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission in 1974, is no longer extant. The building was located on Mt. Oak Road near the intersection of Mt. Oak Road and the Baltimore and Potomac railroad line. The junction became known as Mulliken Station and included a hotel, blacksmith shop, railroad station, post office and school. Only one building, the Phipps House (PG # 74A-12), still stands.

National Register Evaluation:

The site of the Mitchellville Blacksmith's House is not eligible for the National Register of Historic Places. The property is not eligible under Criterion A, as research conducted indicates no association with any historic events or trends significant in the development of national, state or local history. Historic research indicates that the property has no association with persons who have made specific contributions to history, and therefore, it does not meet Criterion B. It is not eligible under Criterion C, as the structure is no longer extant and the site of the structure does not retain sufficient integrity to represent an important architectural trend or distinctive characteristics of a type or method of construction. Finally, the structure has no known potential to yield important information, and therefore, is not eligible under Criterion D.
