Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

SHA Structure No. 1605000 is labeled a double cell box culvert. Each of the two (2) spans are twelve (12) feet in length. Although the structure is termed a box culvert, it does not fit the definition of a small structure (which is less than 20 feet). Since it is a culvert, it is not a bridge – and therefore was not part of SHA's Historic Bridge Inventory.

The 1940 structure has had little repair work, but has a damaged parapet, damaged sidewalk, and part of the but end is hiding under the vegetation.

This property is considered not eligible for the National Register of Historic Places.

- It is not considered eligible under Criterion A as there is no known significant historical event associated with this property.
- It is not considered eligible under Criterion B as there is no known person of significance associated with this house.
- It is not considered eligible under Criterion C as an outstanding example of an architectural style or the work of a master craftsman.
- It is not considered eligible under Criterion D as it is unlikely to contain information that is currently unknown.

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


