Based on available information, 3414 Glenn Drive, a single story brick house possibly constructed prior to WWII, does not meet the National Register criteria for individual listing nor is it located in a known historic district. The low, flat roofed house has a lightly southwestern appearance and is not a common house type for the area. However, it has few, if any, distinctive features outside of its unusual massing and does not appear to be the result of any particular design intent. The neighborhood in which the property is located, Parkland Terrace, is bounded by Suitland Parkway, Silver Hill Road and Suitland Road is composed of two- and three-story red brick, flat roofed apartment buildings from the 1940s, newer three- to four-story apartment buildings from the 1960s, modest one-and-one-half-story brick and frame single family residences of post WWII vintage, and a few older, 1920s bungalows which predate the major development of area which occurred after WWII. The area does not constitute a cohesive district.




