Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo):*

The Gary Property is located on the south side of Marlboro Pike in Forestville, Prince George's County. The property occupies a narrow, deep lot with few trees and includes a circa 1950 house. Because it is used for industrial purposes, most of the property is fenced and locked and was not accessible at the time of this survey. The circa 1950 house is 1-story tall and 3-bays wide. It has a poured concrete foundation, asbestos shingle siding, and an asphalt-shingle, side-gable roof. The main entry occupies the center bay of the front (east) elevation. The 6/6 windows are original and have vinyl paneled shutters.

The Gary Property is not eligible for the National Register of Historic Places. The property is not eligible under Criterion A, as research conducted indicated no association with any historic events or trends significant in the development of local, state or national history. Historic research indicates that the property has no association with persons who have made specific contributions to history, therefore, it does not meet Criterion B. The property is not eligible under Criterion C because it is an indistinguished example of a circa 1950 suburban house, a type which occurs by the thousands in this area. Investigations have not been conducted to determine whether the property has the potential to yield information important to history or pre-history, therefore eligibility under Criterion D cannot be assessed at this time.





Prince George's County Tax Map 90, Parcel 17




